A huge crowd of interested Dairy people from all over Australia and New Zealand overflowed the selling ring at the Malanda Show the evening following judging of the 100th Malanda Show.

Sale top of \$7000 was paid for the Illawarra Jondene Lorna 184 a/c FS Johnston & Sons, this Happy Valley Parker heifer had been placed Hon Men Junior Champion earlier in the day and was purchased by R, J & C Davis. The same buyers also selected Jondene Nell 47 who had earlier won the 2 yo in milk class at \$5000.

J & K Johnston of Hillcrest Illawarras also paid \$5000 for Riverwood Madam 5 a/c Ledger Family from a very high production index dam.

Eachamvale Chance 41 the daughter of the Grand Champion Illawarra cow sold a/c G & B English at \$4750 to Southern Qld breeder John Bradfield.

Second high seller of the night was the Champion Jersey Cow of the show, Long Lanes GG Fernleaf, EX a/c R & C Hartin and bred from the famed Bushlea Fernleafs, she was purchased by MB Daley & Co at \$6000.

Top selling Holstein at \$5000 was Wild Oats Mascalese Gorgeous backed by 9 gens of EX & VG and from the 2015 Qld Cow of the year she was a/c Cochrane & Parker and sold to Tigerdee Holsteins.

Victorian buyer Paul Allott selected the VG 87 cow Myway Lauthor Toni from Owen Daley at \$4500, this top young cow completed 12 gens of EX & VG.
