Next top of \$5400 was paid by the Syndicate of Karl Munden & Chris Morris for Rockvale Burdette Lorna 5, these buyers also selected Rockvale Star Locket 2 a daughter of the 2016 Fanfare Champion Rockvale Reality Locket at \$5000.

Queensland Breeders S & B Wadley selected 2 outstanding heifers, Rockvale Burd Locket 6, a daughter of the EX 92 Pardner Locket 5 cow at \$4000 and Rockvale Sherlock Vivienne at \$3600.
