Third high seller was Fairvale Bradnick Josie 118, VG 85 on 1st lact. a daughter of the EX 94 IDW winning aged cow in 2017 Baxter Josie 64, she sold at \$12500 to Bluechip Genetics and Fairvale, this same buying partnership also paid \$9000 for Fairvale Goldchip Josie 117, BG 87 on 1st lact.

Fourth sale high at \$12000 was Fairvale Dazzler Repa 57, EX 91, 2E selling to K & H Jones of Foster, Vic.

At \$10000 was Fairvale Goldchip Butter 287, VG 86 on 1st lact selling to Elm Banks Holsteins, VIc. Also at \$10000 was Fairvale Fever Repa 56, EX going to T & J Clark of Nerrena, Vic.
