Next top at \$9,000 was the top young cow Robsvue Diamondback Betty, GP 84, this early Diamondback was from a VG Let-It-Snow from a VG 87 Sid then Gold Barbara, EX 95. She was purchased by B Walmsley of Numurkah.

Western Victorian buyers B & L Taylor selected Mario Park K Doc Aleece who had won her large class in the All Breeds National Youth Show earlier in the Week, this correct King Doc sold a/c M & J Polson of NSW at \$7,500.
