Next top price of \$3,800 was Pooley Bridge Sid Val a daughter of an EX 92, 3E dam with 443 kgs fat, she was purchased by L & K Culton.

Top selling Amelia Park lot was Atley Lulu bred from the famed Hanoverhill Lulu family she sold at \$3,700 to Benevento Park Holsteins of Undera.

Return buyers were strong throughout the sale, these buyers included Eloora Past. Co of Blighty, NSW their selections included Pooley Bridge Velvet Spot 83 at \$3,300.
