WWS Evolution sale tops \$12,000

The 6th annual WWS Evolution Sale yet again created much interest with buyers from all parts of Vic, NSW, SA, Tas, WA and New Zealand selecting lots to further enhance their herds.

Sale top of \$12,000 was paid for Cypress Grove V3 Ronimo Tiffany (ET), this 10 month heifer is currently the # 17 BPI female in Australia at +359 and boasts an ASI of +252. Sired by Jeronimo-Poll, her dam is a VG 87 Doorman with 4% protein from the current Australian Cow of the year in Orchard Vale Informer Tiffany, EX 91, this exciting heifer was offered by Mitchell Jones of Foster and purchased by B & J Dickson of Emu Banks Holsteins, Terang.

Second high of \$10,000 was paid for the very correct Red heifer Windy Vale Unstopabull Angle (Imp.ET) a/c Windy Vale Holsteins, SA. Her dam is a Jacoby from an 8th gen EX Uno from the World famous Regiment Apple-Red, EX 96, she was purchased by G & PA Angi of Yarloop, WA.

Third high of \$8,000 was reached twice when Lightning Ridge SMDW Crusbull Princess a/c the PMDW Syndicate sold to the Staley Family of Yarram, this daughter of the VG 89 max Eclipse Octane Princess 13 sold with a PTAT of +3.97 and +3.51 mam. Also at \$8,000 was the 3 month heifer Quality Ridge Undenied Bonnie 81 (ET) a/c J & B Fisher, this daughter of 3rd generation IDW Champion Ashbury Damion Bonnie, VG 88 sold to R Zanders of Kialla.

The fine young in milk heifer Rusty Red Diamondback Becky, a daughter of the 2016 R & W Champion of the Vic Winter Fair sold a/c Judson Jennings at \$7,100 to K Jackson of Welshpool. This same buyer also selected Vala Bouyancy Chandie, a grand daughter of the renowned Larcrest MS Chanda, VG at \$5,000.

The very correct Lightning Ridge-CMD Tatoo Brittany who had won her class at the IDW Youth Show earlier in the week sold a/c M Matius of Portugal to L & K Liccardello of Mardan at \$7,000.

NSW buyers A & C Coombes paid \$6,900 for Waldunc Unix Valana (Imp.ET) a daughter of the EX 95 Jacobs Atwood Vedette a/c Cherrylock Cattle Co. There were several lots that sold at \$6,000, these included Leader Solomon Sandalwood who had won her class at the IDW Youth Show, this grand daughter of the 3rd generation Australian Cow of the year Leader Durham Satin sold a/c A & J Mackie to Kiwi Crew of NZ. The smart red heifer Lightning Ridge WSMR Jordy Calli (Imp.ET) selling a/c Brad Salmon sold at \$6,000 to Cherrylock Cattle Co, while Eastview MC Jordy Bonnie bred down from the 2 time IDW Grand Champion Fairvale Jed Bonnie also sold at \$6,000 from S & P Robinson to the Staley Family. The very last lot in the sale Mario Park King Doc Midas bred from 6 gens of EX & VG dams a/c M & J Polson, NSW also sold at \$6,000 to N Hart of Girgarre.

The Autumn calving heifer Burn Brae Solomon Jane sold at \$5,800 to J Mungean of Timboon from A & J Mackie. Maxmount King Doc Tara, a daughter of the VG 88 Avonlea Windbrook Tara and then backed by a further 10 gens of EX dams sold at \$5,500 to Inlet View Holsteins of Foster, she sold a/c Maxmount Holsteins of Poowong.

Other noted sales included Robsvue Doc Barby a/c R & B Walmsley, SA, her 10th gen EX & VG dam is a grand daughter of the 2019 WDE Grand Champion Gold Barbara, EX 95, she sold at \$5,400 to B & J Dickson of Terang. Avonlea Tatoo Kay a grand daughter of former IDW Junior Champion Fraser Light Kay, EX sold at \$5,200 to Katie Jones of Foster from J & C Gardiner. Mario Park Undenied Allie bred from the Kingsway Allie family sold at \$5,000 to the Castles Family.
