Next top of \$5,100 was for Kings Vale Megapower Rosette, a very stylish River Valley PF Megapower bred from the Countenan Rosa family from NZ, she sold to Saunders & Day of Shady Creek. These buyers also selected Kings Vale Valentino Melanie 2 backed by 4 gens of EX dams at \$4,000 and Kings Vale Brunette 361, a Megapower from a Valentino dam at \$3,900.
